WHITE WINE



1. False Bay - Chenin Blanc (Biodynamic) €36
South Africa Available by glass: € 9
Dried herbaceous notes, including fennel and aniseed, followed by a creamy lemon finish.
2. Paddocks Chardonnay €36
Australia Available by glass: €9
A juicy, sun-packed Australian Chardonnay with peach and tropical fruit flavour and a fresh finish.
3. Lucci, Pinot Grigio €38
Italy, Veneto Available by glass: € 9.50
A tasty, fresh Pinot Grigio with fruity flavours of apple and pear and a crisp lemon and lime finish.
4. Pa Road Sauvignon Blanc €40
New Zealand, Marlborough Available by glass: € 10
Tropical fruit flavours of pineapple, mango and kiwi on the palate, with ripe mandarin and citrus flavours adding a zesty freshness.
5. Les Nuages Sauvignon Blanc €40
France, Languedoc Available by glass: € 10
Golden, pale straw in colour. A lively Loire Sauvignon with notes of fresh citrus fruits on the palate. Soft and delicate with perfect acidity.
6. Cap Cette de Picpoul €40
France, Languedoc Available by glass: € 10
Pale straw hue with olive reflections. Fresh, briny aromas of citrus, kelp and pears, with a mid-weight, tingly, mineraly palate of lemon, refreshing and intense.
7. Pere Anselme, Reserve De L'Aube €42
France, Cotes du Rhone
This wine is light, refreshing with a well-balanced taste. Its light yellow colour with greenish hues fills the glass with tones of spring flowers and citrus fruits.
8. Dopf & Irion Riesling €45
France, Alsace
Intense rich aromas, offering all the fragrances of a basketful of ripe lemons, green apples and limes. With its hints of honey this Riesling has a rich mouth feel.
9. Nia Albarino E Senora €46
Spain, Rias Baixas
A mineral style with restrained fruit on the nose but very expressive on the palate full of apple fruit flavours with a round finish. Very classy style of Albarino.

WHITE WINE



10. Tommasi Lugana €47
Italy, Lugana- Veneto
100% Trebbiano di Lugana from a single vineyard. Tropical fruits, white flowers and spicy aromas. A medium bodied, clean and spicy white highlighted by delicious hints of tropical fruit with a clean crisp finish.
11. Huber Gruner Veltliner Obere Steigen €50
Austria, Traisental
This single vineyard wine from Austria's most famous grape is crisp, weighty and aromatic with flavours of peach, pear and apricot and a super crisp finish.
12. Chablis, Domaine Charly Nicolle €52
France, Burgundy
A pale yellow with a perfume of summer flowers and a crisp minerality. True, classic authentic Chablis at its best.
13. Chatelain Sancerre, €60
France, Loire Valley (France) VCORAVIN €16
Super-crisp and super-tasty with a flavour of kiwi, gooseberry and green apple, this is a wine of power, elegance and balance.
14. Marquis de Goulaine Sancerre Les Lorys €60
France, Sancerre VCORAVIN €16
An expressive wine, with floral and fruity notes; slightly vegetal. The palate is fresh on the attack, really fleshy and full-bodied with typical sauvignon characteristics of grass and lime.
15. Jean Becker Gewurztraminer €60
France, Alsace
Big and rich, with all of those lychees, rose petal and floral aromas you expect from a Gewurztraminer - and some sweetness.
16. Bouchard Aine, Pouilly Fuissé €85
France, Burgundy
Elegant, fairly reticent, very mineral with flowery, vegetal undertones enlivened with a honey note. This leaves the palate very well balanced.
17. Antonin Rodet Mersault €130
France, Burgundy Côte De Beaune VCORAVIN €36
100% Chardonnay. Beautiful green-gold colour with silvery tint, clear and shiny. On nose, delicate and fine with aromas of fresh almond and hazelnut with lemony notes. On the palate, fruity with savours of honey and brioche.

ROSÉ WINE



18. **Domaine de la Petite Croix Rosé** €40
D'Anjou - Loire, France Available by glass: €10
This wine shows delicate red berry fruit flavours and a very fresh and crisp palate. Initial sweet fruit flavours especially strawberries turn to a dry and fresh finish. The ultimate wine for sipping on sunny afternoons.

DESSERT WINE



19. **Vina Morande Late harvest Sauvignon** €35
Chile, (½ Bottle)
Bright gleaming golden-yellow. Exuberant, quince, papaya, jasmine and vanilla. Crystallised fruit, magnolia, papaya and honey. Sweet, silky smooth and complex.

SPARKLING



20. **Bosco dei Cirmioli Prosecco Frizzante** €38
Italy, Veneto Available by glass: €9.50
Aromas of flowers, apples and pears, delicate fruity flavours and light bubbles.
21. **Maschio Dei Cavalieri Frizzante** €38
Italy, Campegine Available by glass: €9.50
Fruity with flavours of ripe pear, apple, peach and blossom. 'Frizzante' means that it is only lightly sparkling.
22. **Furlan Spumante Rosé** €48
Italy
Spumante is a fully sparkling wine. This is a blend of Glera and Manzoni grapes, giving a pale pink salmon colour. It is fresh and crisp with gentle nuances of strawberry flavour.
23. **Bosco Prosecco Spumante** €48
Italy, Veneto
Classic Prosecco Frizzante Bianco from Veneto. Fresh, fruity and aromatic on the nose. Peach, pear and pink lady apple on the palate. Lightly sparkling with mouth-watering acidity. Easy drinking bubbles that offer a great aperitif.

RED WINE



24. **Torrelongares Tempranillo** €38
Spain, Carinena Available by glass: €9.50
An unoaked Tempranillo from the Carinena region in Spain. There are no harsh edges, just smooth and mellow fruity Tempranillo.
25. **Siete Cuchillos - Malbec** €38
Argentina, Mendoza Available by glass: €9.50
Deep Violet in colour, with a rich ripe blackberry fruit aroma. There's no wood, just intense, jammy, chocolatey flavours.
26. **Les Oliviers – Merlot/Mourvedre** €36
France, Languedoc Available by glass: €9
Very dark red and bright. Plum and dark fruit aromas with notes of spicy and pepper accents. Soft and fleshy with elegant tannins. Intense flavours of red jammy fruits finishing long with notes of vanilla.
27. **Terroir Littoral Cabernet Sauvignon, Fortant** €38
France, Languedoc Available by glass: €9.50
This intense ruby red wine has an impressive aroma, full of blackcurrants with a touch of eucalyptus synonymous to Cabernet Sauvignon. It is ripe and full bodied with juicy dark fruit flavours and a good firm backbone.
28. **Ederra Crianza** €40
Spain, Rioja Available by glass: €10
Aromas of ripe red fruit underlain with notes of vanilla, coconut and cocoa. A very pleasant wine on the palate.
29. **Pere Anselme Cotes du Rhone** €40
'Domaine de Grivelle' France
Well-balanced with aromas of red fruits and spices with mild hints of vanilla and earth. Rich, full bodied and round in the mouth. The finish is long with mild tannins
30. **Chateau Les Moutins Red,** €42
France, Bordeaux
Made mostly from soft and fleshy Merlot, blended with a little cassis-like Cabernet, this is a really classy oak-aged Claret. Super fruits-of-the-forest flavours
31. **Foundstone Shiraz** €42
Australia,
Concentrated fruity flavours of blackberry, black cherry and plum are supported by more complex flavours of coffee, vanilla and caramel from the oak-ageing.
32. **Castellani Chianti Classico** €44
Italy, Toscana
From the best area in Chianti, a vivacious ruby red colour. Fruity fragrance, hints of violet, cherry and wild red berries. Full-bodied, dry and traditional with a final touch of cherry and pepper
33. **Bouchard Aine et Fils Fleurie** €45
France, Bordeaux
A pale crimson in colour. Flowery, fruit aromas. Subtle and well-balanced. A medium bodied silky wine with plenty of body and juicy summer red fruit flavours and a spicy finish.

RED WINE



34. Tommasi Arele €46
Italy, Delle-Venezie
This intense, deep ruby red is made from partially dried Valpolicella grapes. It has a very fruity nose; full of sweet red cherries with some spicy black pepper evident also. A full-bodied red with delicious sweet fruit flavours and an intense spicy undercurrent. Smooth with a long finish
35. Santa Sofia, Valpolicella Ripasso, €52
Italy, Veneto
This wine is a Valpolicella, too, but made altogether differently. Once the great Amarone is made, the Ripasso grapes are fermented on its skins, adding richness and power. It is then aged in Slovenian barrels. It's rich, intense and delicious.
36. J Lohr Seven Oaks Cabernet Sauvignon €56
USA, California
A deep red-purple in colour, it has rich, ripe aromas of blackcurrant, blueberry and cherry overlaid with toasty notes and a touch of vanilla from the oak ageing. It has surprisingly gentle tannins and a soft finish
37. Chateau l'Annonciation, €70
St Emilion Grand Cru, France, Bordeaux-Libournais ▼CORAVIN €20
A full-bodied soft and smooth wine with lots of plum and damson-flavoured fruit, typical of the Merlot grape
38. La fiole Du Pape Rouge, €76
Chateaufeuf du Pape ,France, Rhone Valley
Aromas of ripe berries, Morello cherry, warm spices (cinnamon, clove, nutmeg), truffles, game and cedar. Elegant and well balanced with mature flavours of leather, spiced forest fruits and roasted game. Powerful, persistent flavours ensure a wine of excellent length.
39. Château Teyssier, Margaux €90
France, Bordeaux- Médoc ▼CORAVIN €25
Excellent example of a classic Bordeaux, showing good bramble fruits with a nice touch of cedar. Fruit, acidity and tannins are all very well balanced
40. Château Nenin Pomerol €90
France, Bordeaux ▼CORAVIN €25
Bright ruby colour, with a beautiful fruity bouquet and velvety tannins. It is a supple and very pleasant wine.
41. Château Pontac Lynch €105
Cru Bourgeois Margaux France ▼CORAVIN €28
A Cabernet- based blend from the famous commune of Margaux. This is a very fine Bordeaux, perfect for drinking now. 'Seductive nose of soft, warm fruit. Subdued, thick chewy fruit; blackcurrant and cassis. Dense, ripe and very finely tuned. Hints of oak with great length.
42. Amarone di Valpolicella. €110
Italy, Santa Sofia ▼CORAVIN €30
A very special made from sun-dried grapes wine that's full-bodied and concentrated, with an intense, herb-filled character. Elegant and powerful.
43. Chateau Lagrange Saint Julien 2010 €200
France, St Julien, Bordeaux
2010 was a great vintage in Bordeaux and St Julien is renowned for making the most classical wines in Bordeaux. Chateau Lagrange have created a wine of great depth and style with flavours of cassis, black cherry and cedar wood.

CHAMPAGNE



44. Laurent Perrier Brut NV (Vegan) €120
France, Champagne
This signature Laurent Perrier has a refined, fresh and elegant nose with brioche and delicate citrus flavours.
45. Laurent Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut (Vegan) €220
France, Champagne
If Champagne says a lot, a Rosé Champagne says that much more. This is a very aromatic wine with red berry fruit, pomegranate and apples. A medium to full-bodied Rosé with a delicate mousse.
46. Moët & Chandon €130
France, Champagne
The palate is seductive, richly flavourful and smooth combining generosity and elegance, fullness and finesse, followed by a delicately fresh crispiness (fruit with seeds), to reveal the magical balance of champagne.
47. Moët & Chandon Rosé €160
France, Champagne
Intense aromas of red summer berries (strawberry, raspberry and redcurrant) with floral notes (rose, hawthorn) and a light peppery touch.
48. Veuve Clicquot Ponsardine €140
France, Champagne
The predominance of Pinot Noir provides the structure that is so typically Clicquot, while a touch of Pinot Meunier rounds out the blend. Chardonnay adds the elegance and finesse essential in a perfectly balanced wine.
49. Dom Perignon, 2010 €320
France, Champagne
On the nose, aromas of almond and powdered cocoa develop gradually into white fruit with hints of dried flowers. Classic toasted notes give a rounded finish and denote a fully realized maturity. On the palate, the wine instantly traces an astoundingly fine line between density and weightlessness. Its precision is extreme, tactile, dark and chiselled. The full taste lingers with the utmost elegance on a sappy, spicy notes.
