WHITE WINE



1. Lucci, Pinot Grigio

€38

Italy, Veneto

Available by glass: € 9.50

A tasty, fresh Pinot Grigio with fruity flavours of apple and pear and a crisp lemon and lime finish.

2. Pa Road Sauvignon Blanc

€40

New Zealand, Marlborough

Available by glass: € 10

Tropical fruit flavours of pineapple, mango and kiwi on the palate, with ripe mandarin and citrus flavours adding a zesty freshness.

3 Les Nuages Sauvignon Blanc

€40

France, Languedoc

Available by glass: € 10

Golden, pale straw in colour. A lively Loire Sauvignon with notes of fresh citrus fruits on the palate. Soft and delicate with perfect acidity.

4. Herbe Saint Chardonnay, Languedoc

€40

France

Available by glass: €10

Herbe Sainte's grpaes are all grown on the family estate. The Chardonnay is medium-bodied, round on the palate and nicely fruity with flavours of apples and honeydew melon.

5. Etra Albarino

€45

Rias Baixas, Galicia, Spain

Available by glass: € 12

A mineral style with restrained fruit on the nose but very expressive on the palate full of apple fruit flavours with a round finish. Very classy style of Albarino.

6. Treize Vents Picpoul de Pinet

€40

France, Languedoc

Available by glass: € 10

An attractive green-gold in colour, this wine is full-bodied and rich in the mouth with a mouth-watering lemon zesty freshness and crispness.

7. False Bay - Chenin Blanc (Biodynamic)

€40

South Africa

Dried herbaceous notes, including fennel and aniseed, followed by a creamy lemon finish

8. Pere Anselme, Reserve De L'Aube

€42

France, Cotes du Rhone

This wine is light, refreshing with a well-balanced taste. Its light yellow colour with greenish hues fills the glass with tones of spring flowers and citrus fruits.

Dopf & Irion Riesling

€45

France, Alsace

Intense rich aromas, offering all the fragrances of a basketful of ripe lemons, green apples and limes. With its hints of honey this Riesling has a rich mouth feel.



10. Tommasi Lugana

€47

Italy, Lugana- Veneto

100% Trebbiano di Lugana from a single vineyard. Tropical fruits, white flowers and spicy aromas. A medium bodied, clean and spicy white highlighted by delicious hints of tropical fruit with a clean crisp finish.

Huber Gruner Veltliner Obere Steigen 11.

Austria, Traisentac

This single vineyard wine from Austria's most famous grape is crisp, weighty and aromatic with flavours of peach, pear and apricot and a super crisp finish.

Chablis, Domaine Charly Nicolle 12.

France, Burgundy

A pale yellow with a perfume of summer flowers and a crisp minerality. True, classic authentic Chablis at its best.

Chatelain Sancerre, 13.

France, Loire Valley (France)

VCORAVIN €16

Super-crisp and super-tasty with a flavour of kiwi, gooseberry and green apple, this is a wine of power, elegance and balance.

An expressive wine, with floral and fruity notes; slightly vegetal. The palate is fresh on the attack, really fleshy and full-bodied with typical sauvignon characteristics of grass and lime.

15. Bouchard Aine, Pouilly Fuissè

€65

France, Burgundy

Elegant, fairly reticent, very mineral with flowery, vegetal undertones enlivened with a honey note. This leaves the palate very well balanced.

16. **Antonin Rodet Mersault**

€130

France, Burgundy Côte De Beaune

VCORAVIN' €36

100% Chardonnay. Beautiful green-gold colour with silvery tint, clear and shiny. On nose, delicate and fine with aromas of fresh almond and hazelnut with lemony notes. On the palate, fruity with savours of honey and brioche.



17. Torrelongares Tempranillo

€38

Spain, Carinena

Available by glass: €9.50

An unoaked Tempranillo from the Carinena region in Spain. There are no harsh edges, just smooth and mellow fruity Tempranillo.

18. Cassone Reserva - Malbec

€42

Argentina, Mendoza

Available by glass: €11

Deep Violet in colour, with a rich ripe blackberry fruit aroma. There's no wood, just intense, jammy, chocolatey flavours.

19. Les Oliviers - Merlot

€36

France, Languedoc

Available by glass: €9

Very dark red and bright. Plum and dark fruit aromas with notes of spicy and pepper accents. Soft and fleshy with elegant tannins. Intense flavours of red jammy fruits finishing long with notes of vanilla.

20. Herbe Sainte Cabernet Sauvignon,

€40

France, Languedoc

Available by glass: €10

Aromas of ripe blackcurrants develop into flavours of rich and juicy bramble fruits

21. Mileto Rioja Crianza

€45

Spain, Rioja

Available by glass: €12

Very intense dark cherry red colour. Good fruity intensity, with nuances of cherries, strawberries, licorice and woody notes perfectly integrated in the wine. Good entrance in the mouth; structured wine with balanced acidity and a long finish.

22. Pere Anselme Cotes du Rhone

€40

Domaine de Grivelle' France

Well-balanced with aromas of red fruits and spices with mild hints of vanilla and earth. Rich, full bodied and round in the mouth. The finish is long with mild tannins.

23. Chateau Les Moutins Red,

€42

France, Bordeaux

Made mostly from soft and fleshy Merlot, blended with a little cassis-like Cabernet, this is a really classy oak-aged Claret. Super fruits-of-the-forest flavours.

24. Foundstone Shiraz

€42

Australia,

Concentrated fruity flavours of blackberry, black cherry and plum are supported by more complex flavours of coffee, vanilla and caramel from the oak-ageing.

25. Bevi Montepulciano D'Abruzzo

€42

Italy

With rich, dark-berried fruit flavours and smooth body, this has a touch of that attractive "sour cherry" character so typical of Italian wines.

26. Bouchard Aine et Fils Fleurie

€45

France, Bordeaux

A pale crimson in colour. Flowery, fruit aromas. Subtle and well-balanced. A medium bodied silky wine with plenty of body and juicy summer red fruit flavours and a spicy finish.

RED WINE



Tommasi Arele, 27.

€46

Italy, Delle-Venezie

This intense, deep ruby red is made from partially dried Valpolicella grapes. It has a very fruity nose; full of sweet red cherries with some spicy black pepper evident also. A full-bodied red with delicious sweet fruit flavours and an intense spicy undercurrent. Smooth with a long finish.

28. Santa Sofia, Valpolicella Ripasso,

€52

Italy, Veneto

This wine is a Valpolicella, too, but made altogether differently. Once the great Amarone is made, the Ripasso grapes are fermented on its skins, adding richness and power. It is then aged in Slovenian barrels. It's rich, intense and delicious.

J Lohr Seven Oaks Cabernet Sauvignon 29.

USA, California

A deep red-purple in colour, it has rich, ripe aromas of blackcurrant, blueberry and cherry overlaid with toasty notes and a touch of vanilla from the oak ageing. It has surprisingly gentle tannins and a soft finish

Chateau l'Annonciation,

St Emilion Grand Cru, France, Bordeaux-Libournais

A full-bodied soft and smooth wine with lots of plum and damson-flavoured fruit, typical of the Merlot grape

La Fiole Du Pape Rouge,

€76

Chateaneuf du Pape, France, Rhone Valley Concentrated raspberry, black cherry and damson jam aromas on the nose lead to intense autumnal fruit flavours on the palate. There is bags of rich, dense fruity character.

Château Teyssier, Margaux 32.

€90

France, Bordeaux- Médoc

Excellent example of a classic Bordeaux, showing good bramble fruits with a nice touch of cedar. Fruit, acidity and tannins are all very well balanced

33. Château Nenin Pomerol

€90

France, Bordeaux

Bright ruby colour, with a beautiful fruity bouquet and velvety tannins. It is a supple and very pleasant wine.

Château Pontac Lynch

€105 VCORAVIN €28

Cru Bourgeois Margaux France

A Cabernet- based blend from the famous commune of Margaux. This is a very fine Bordeaux, perfect for drinking now. 'Seductive nose of soft, warm fruit. Subdued, thick chewy fruit; blackcurrant and cassis. Dense, ripe and very finely tuned. Hints of oak with great length.

Tommasi Amarone Della Valpolicella . 35.

Italy, Veneto

Very intense ruby red color, the nose reveals intense and clean scents of very ripe cherry, black cherry, wild berries followed by fresh and slightly spicy tones.

36. Chateau Lagrange Saint Julien 2010

€200

France, St Julien, Bordeaux

2010 was a great vintage in Bordeaux and St Julien is renowned for making the most classical wines in Bordeaux. Chateau Lagrange have created a wine of great depth and style with flavours of cassis, black cherry and cedar wood.

37. Classique Rosé

€40

Ardeche, France Available by glass: €10

A fresh and crisp yet mouthwatering rosé with subtle aromas of strawberry and pink grapefruit.

DESSERT WINE



38. Brumes de la Tour Blanche Sauternes

€35

Bordeaux, France (½ Bottle) Available by glass: €15
Aromas of sweet barley sugar are followed on the palate by an amazing concentration of intense apricot, honey and peach flavours finished off with crisp and refreshing lemon and lime character.

Great length of flavour.

SPARKLING



39. Bosco dei Cirmioli Prosecco Frizzante

€42

Italy, Vento Available by glass: €9.50

Aromas of flowers, apples and pears, delicate fruity flavours and light bubbles.

40. Furlan Spumante Rosé

€48

Italy

Spumante is a fully sparkling wine. This is a blend of Glera and Manzoni grapes, giving a pale pink salmon colour. It is fresh and crisp with gentle nuances of strawberry flavour.

41. Bosco Prosecco Spumante

€48

Italy, Veneto

Classic Prosecco Frizzante Bianco from Veneto. Fresh, fruity and aromatic on the nose. Peach, pear and pink lady apple on the palate. Lightly sparkling with mouth-watering acidity. Easy drinking bubbles that offer a great aperitif.

CHAMPAGNE



42. Laurent Perrier Brut NV (Vegan)

€120

France, Champagne

This signature Laurent Perrier has a refined, fresh and elegant nose with brioche and delicate citrus flavours.

43. Laurent Perrier Brut NV (Vegan)

€120

France, Champagne

If Champagne says a lot, a Rosé Champagne says that much more. This is a very aromatic wine with red berry fruit, pomegranate and apples. A medium to full-bodied Rosé with a delicate mousse.

44. Moet & Chandon

€130

France, Champagne

The palate is seductive, richly flavourful and smooth combining generosity and elegance, fullness and finesse, followed by a delicately fresh crispiness (fruit with seeds), to reveal the magical balance of champagne.

45. Moet & Chandon Rosé

€160

France, Champagne

Intense aromas of red summer berries (strawberry, raspberry and redcurrant) with floral notes (rose, hawthorn) and a light peppery touch.

46. Vueve Clicquot Ponsardine

€140

France, Champagne

The predominance of Pinot Noir provides the structure that is so typically Clicquot, while a touch of Pinot Meunier rounds out the blend. Chardonnay adds the elegance and finesse essential in a perfectly balanced wine.

47. Dom Perignon, 2010

€320

France, Champagne

On the nose, aromas of almond and powdered cocoa develop gradually into white fruit with hints of dried flowers. Classic toasted notes give a rounded finish and denote a fully realized maturity. On the palate, the wine instantly traces an astoundingly fine line between density and weightlessness. Its precision is extreme, tactile, dark and chiselled. The full taste lingers with the utmost elegance on a sappy, spicy notes.
